


- (3) Mulch Blades

Tools Required:

A socket wrench set will make assembly easier. Standard wrench sizes are listed.

- (2) 7/16" wrenches
- (1) 5/8" wrench (Blade Bolt)
- (1) #1 or #2 Phillips Screwdriver (Mulch Cover)





CAUTION: Muffler and other engine parts become extremely hot during operation and remain hot after engine has stopped. To avoid severe burns on contact, stay away from these areas.

TO CONVERT TO BAGGING OR DISCHARGING

For best bagging and discharging install the high lift blades.

- Remove the mulch cover and mulch blades and install high lift blades.
- Store mulch cover and mulch blades in a safe place. Your mower is now ready for discharging or installation of optional grass catcher accessory.

MULCHING MOWING TIPS

IMPORTANT: FOR BEST PERFORMANCE, KEEP MOWER HOUSING FREE OF BUILT-UP GRASS AND TRASH. CLEAN AFTER EACH USE.

- The special mulch blades will recut the grass clippings many times and reduce them in size so that as they fall onto the lawn they will disperse into the grass and not be noticed. Also, the mulched grass will biodegrade quickly to provide nutrients for the lawn. Always mulch with your highest engine (blade) speed as this will provide the best recutting action of the blades.
- Avoid cutting your lawn when it is wet. Wet grass tends to form clumps and interferes with the mulching action. The best time to mow your lawn is the early afternoon. At this time the grass has dried and the newly cut area will not be exposed to the direct sun.
- For best results, adjust the mower cutting height so that the mower cuts off only the top one-third of the grass blades. For extremely heavy mulching, reduce your width of cut and mow slowly.
- Certain types of grass and grass conditions may require that an area be mulched a second time to completely hide the clippings. When doing a second cut, mow across or perpendicular to the first cut path.
- Change your cutting pattern from week to week. Mow north to south one week then change to east to west the next week. This will help prevent matting and graining of the lawn.
